Obituary

Mr. Ray James Lunnan III, 60, of Frederick, passed away on August 24, 2016 at Frederick Memorial Hospital. He was the husband of Darla Faith Lunnan, of Frederick, his wife of 24 years. Born in Rantoul, IL, he was the son of Colonel Ray J. Lunnan, Jr. USAF (Ret) and Gloria (Nabors) Lunnan of State College, PA.
