Former Frederick, MD resident, Arnold John Grice, died at the age of 90 on July 21, 2014, in St. Petersburg, FL with his eldest daughter by his side. He was born May 2, 1924 in Hosapple PA to Helen and Jess Grice. He served in the Army during WWII as a Supply Sergeant, and then was shipped stateside where he continued his service performing Explosive Ordinance Disposal. After his military service he married Doris Pauline (Shaw) Grice who preceded him into eternity. During his career he had ownership in several businesses including Grice's Restaurant in Frederick and Conn Organ Studios in Baltimore. He retired from Hiltner's Furniture Store in the late 80's.
