Frank Maynard Hawkins, 76 of Libertytown, MD, retired in Lyman, SC, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on March 19, 2023. Frank was born in Takoma Park, MD to Mary and James W. Hawkins, Sr. He attended Wheaton High School and was a member of the Kensington VFD Company 18.

Frank married the love of his life and best friend Joanne Giannini and together they had three children, James Michael (Jimmy), Angell (Hawkins Borda), and Brandy (Culbertson). He is survived by wife, Joanne, daughters Angell and Brandy, grandchildren: Dustin, Angelica, Christian, Cade, and Lily, brother James W. Hawkins, nephew Frank W. 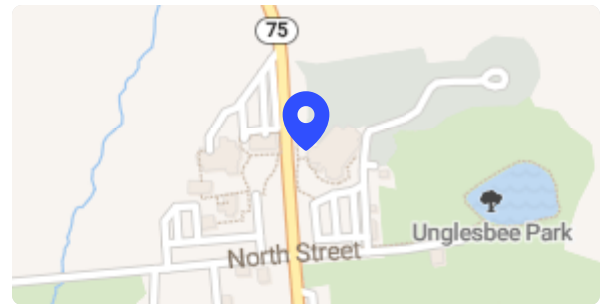
