**M**iddletown, Maryland – Robert Martin Wheeler, 83, passed away on November 2, 2023 after a period of declining health.

Rob was born in Manchester, NH on November 22, 1939 to Norwin and Lois (Rivers) Wheeler. After living in Georgia, Florida, and Alaska, the family relocated back to Manchester, NH where Rob graduated from Manchester West High School. From there, Rob attended the University of Florida before entering the United States Air Force where he specialized in communications. After eight years with the USAF, Rob began a 40-year career with IBM working in New Haven, CT; Waltham, MA; Bedford, NH; and finally, Gaithersburg, MD.

Rob enjoyed golf, bowling, fishing, a good poker game, travel, all-you-can eat crab dinners, and getting the last morsel of meat out of a New England lobster. Prior to Google Maps and Waze, Rob was the one you depended upon to provide directions to anywhere ensuring the avoidance of construction, traffic, potholes and speed traps, as well as sharing all of the sights to see along the way.
