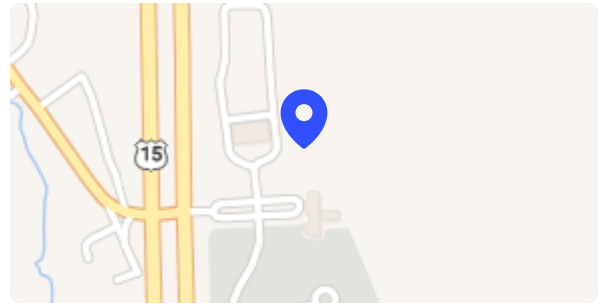

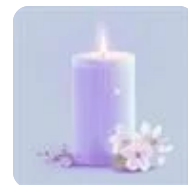
Bryon Short posted:
