The Celebration of Life will be held at the Resthaven Funeral Home August 26, 2024 beginning at 10:00am.



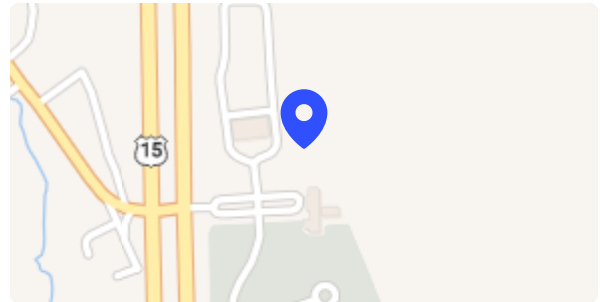

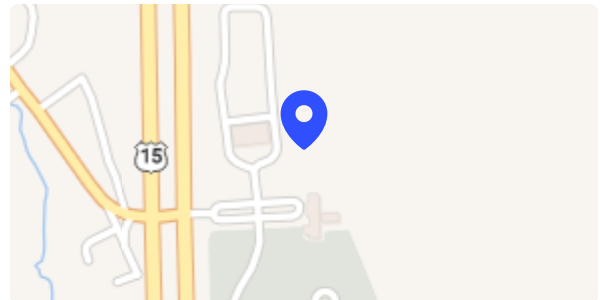

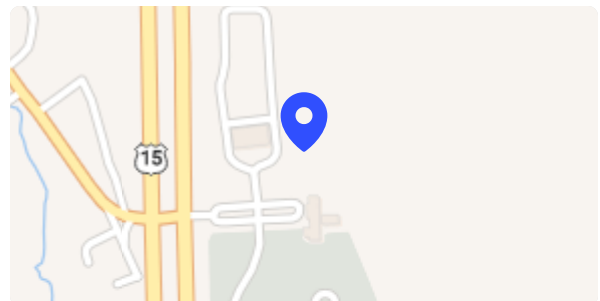
