Esther was born in North Dakota on November 21, 1924, the daughter, the daughter of Ernest and Frances Landon. 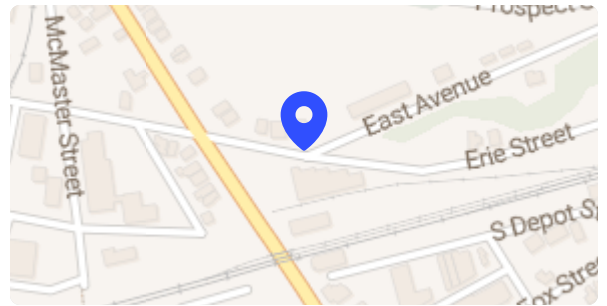
